

Comments:


AMT P-40F/L reboxed by AmTech with corrected resin nose. Nose had shrunk, lot of blending required. AMT P-40's are first of really modern P-40 kits, recessed panel lines good shape, many variants. Easier to build than Hasegawa, but detail is basic (especially the cockpit). Can be had for as little as \$5 at shows.

Aircraft depicts P-40L of 86<sup>th</sup> Fighter

Squadron/79<sup>th</sup> Fighter Group, Italy, 1944. Aircraft originally in desert camo, but pilot (Lt. Erwin Silsbee) repainted the fuselage with paint he found on base (either British or Italian). I liked the Italian paint idea, and the photo I found of this aircraft showed a very dark color, so I assumed it might be Verde Oliva Scuro. Decals from kit. had to overcoat, as they tended to break up in water. Kit sliding canopy section is lopsided (one side thicker than the other), so replaced with Squadron vacuform.
